

Management's Assertion Regarding Disbursements for Eligible Green Projects

Wisconsin Power and Light Company ("WPL") is responsible for the completeness, accuracy and validity of the Schedule of Net Proceeds from Wisconsin Power and Light Company's Debenture Issuance and Related Disbursements (the "Schedule") included below for the period from September 21, 2020 through December 13, 2022. Management of WPL asserts that an amount in excess of the net proceeds from the August 15, 2022, issuance of the \$600 million aggregate principal amount of 3.95% debentures due 2032 was disbursed by WPL during the period from September 21, 2020 through December 13, 2022 for the construction and development of the Eligible Green Projects in accordance with the criteria set forth in Note 1 ("Eligible Green Projects Criteria") in the Schedule.

Note to the Schedule of Net Proceeds from Wisconsin Power and Light Company's Debenture Issuance and Related Disbursements

Note 1. Eligible Green Projects Criteria

WPL's Eligible Green Projects include construction and development of solar electric generating facilities with costs to interconnect these renewable facilities. Expenditures for the Eligible Green Projects consist of solar panels, procurement, engineering and construction costs, and other third-party direct costs disbursed for development of solar electric generating facilities. The timeframe for disbursements is the period from September 21, 2020 through December 13, 2022.
